"Every mark you make must be a response to something you see now, not something you saw yesterday or something you think you ought to see."

Normally we look at something just enough to get by. We look at, say, a cup of coffee just enough to be able to hold and drink it, and we look at a person just enough to register who and where they are and what they are doing. To paint them, however, you must see shapes, lines, colours and tone. This way of looking results in a special communication between you, the painter and subject, in which you are focussed entirely on the present moment. The more you paint the more you see and the more you see the better you paint.



"Painting to see" will contain paintings from Julia's collection of oils, watercolours and film photographs, most notably portraits of the

four Escala Girls, the stunning electric string quartet known from "Britain's Got Talent" 2008, Garfield Jackson, violist and founder member of the Endellion Quartet, legendary TV personality from the Yorkshire Dales and Robin Devenish, particle physicist and winner of the Max Born prize in 2009.



So come and take a look. **Julia will demonstrate her work by painting a limited number of impressionist portraits. These will be done in sittings of 2-3 hours. To arrange a sitting time contact her using the details stated below.**

The exhibition runs from November 10th to November 17th and will be held at The Colomb Art Gallery, 52a George Street, Marylebone, London, W1U 7EA, which is two streets North of Selfridges.
